CHAIRMAN'S AWARD

DEFINITION

The Chairman's Award is intended to recognize exceptional contributions of an individual or individuals who have rendered meritorious service to the Association and the intermodal industry.

FREQUENCY

The IANA Chairman and Board of Directors may choose not to offer this award in any given year, in the event that no appropriate candidates are identified. This is intended not to be an annual award, but granted by the IANA Board of Directors based upon the Association's recognition of commendable contributions.

CANDIDATE CRITERIA

The award is made to an individual or individuals based upon:

- Meritorious contribution to the Association
- Exemplary staff service to the Association
- Long-standing voluntary service to the Association
- Impact of continuing contributions on the intermodal freight transportation industry
- Past or present membership in IANA is required, or in the case of staff service, past or present employment by the Association
