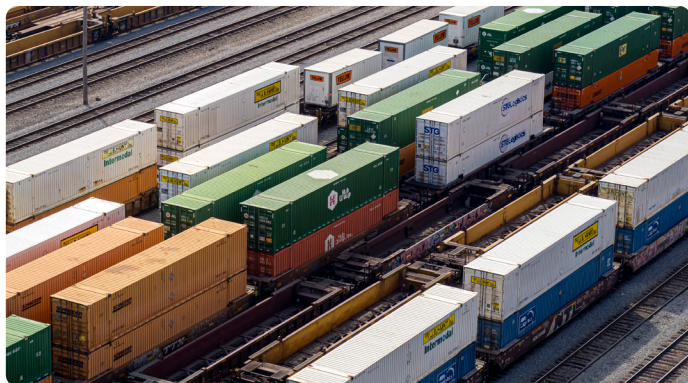


Use rail in more places
