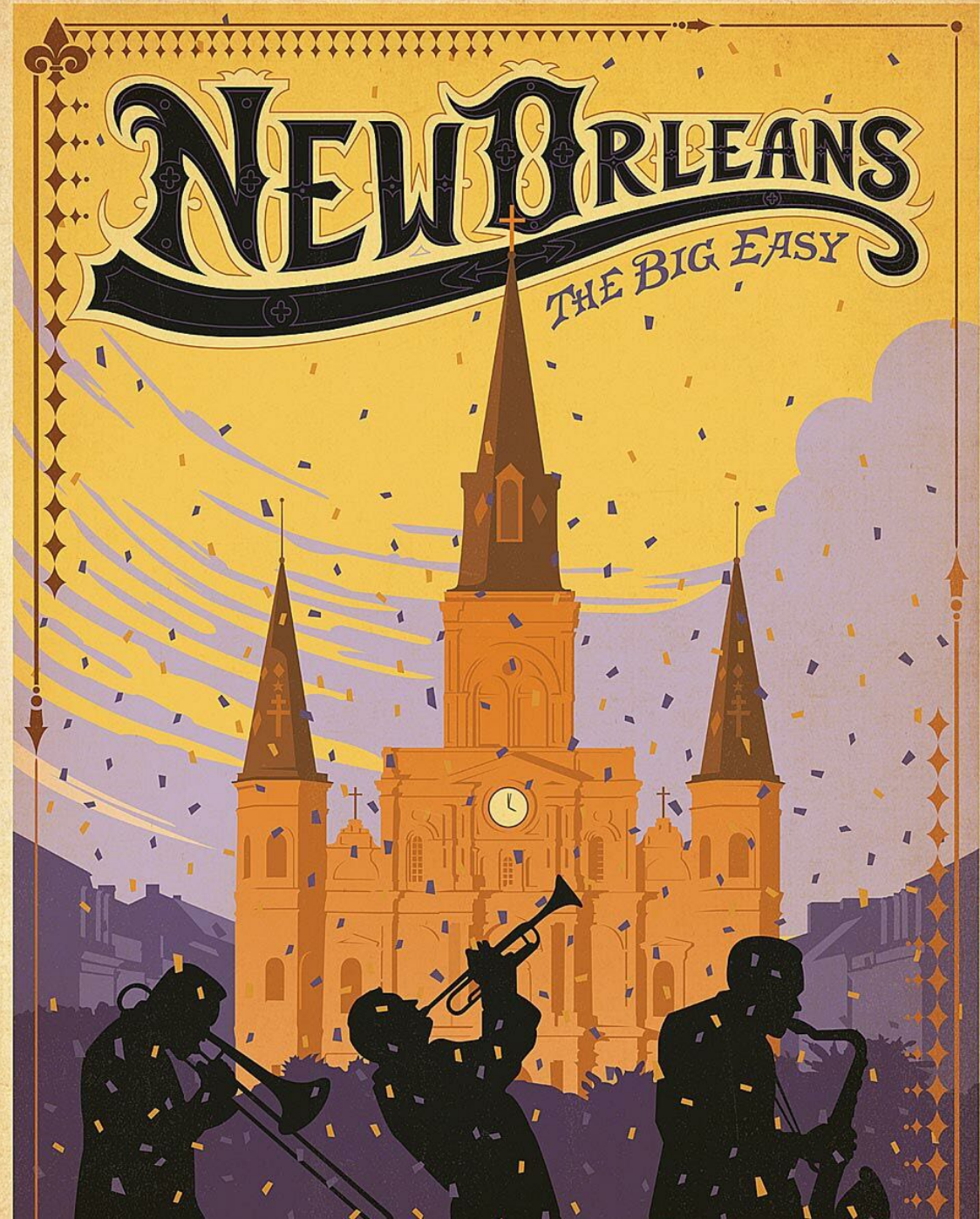

# Policy Priorities

## Protecting Independent Contractors

IANA opposes attempts to impose employee-driver mandates on the intermodal trucker/drayage industry.

## Addressing the Impending Driver Shortage

IANA supports policies allowing drivers between the ages of 18-21 to enter the interstate workforce, under specific training and safety provisions.

## Combatting Cargo Theft & Fraud

IANA supports federal efforts to swiftly identify and combat fraud and theft in the freight industry.

## Reauthorizing the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

IANA supports advancing intermodal freight through provisions related to surface transportation bills.

## Opposing Class I Railroad Re-regulation

IANA opposes any legislation that substantially changes the current laws under which freight railroads operate.

## Maintaining Truck Size & Weight Limits

IANA supports maintaining the current truck size and weight limits to ensure motorist safety and reduce the financial impact of infrastructure maintenance.
