

Policy Priorities

Protecting Independent Contractors

IANA opposes attempts to impose employee-driver mandates on the intermodal trucker/drayage industry.

Addressing the Impending Driver Shortage

IANA supports policies allowing drivers between the ages of 18-21 to enter the interstate workforce, under specific training and safety provisions.

Combatting Cargo Theft & Fraud

IANA supports federal efforts to swiftly identify and combat fraud and theft in the freight industry.

Reauthorizing the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)

IANA supports advancing intermodal freight through provisions related to surface transportation bills.

Opposing Class I Railroad Re-regulation

IANA opposes any legislation that substantially changes the current laws under which freight railroads operate.
