Virtual Meeting

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:03 p.m. by Committee Vice Chairman Jason Hunt of Georgia Ports Authority. IANA General Counsel Marc Blubaugh provided the anti-trust guidelines; a quorum was established as being present.

Approval of the September 12, 2021 Minutes

Mr. Hunt asked for approval of the September 12, 2021, meeting minutes. EJ Bronwasser of Milestone Equipment Holdings made the motion; it was seconded by Ron Cordova of Zonar Systems, Inc. The minutes were approved.

Task Force and Working Group Reports

Terminal Traffic Safety Task Force

Mr. Hunt said the Task Force has been meeting over the last several months to gather data from various terminals across North America, specifically focused on traffic accidents happening on those terminals. He thanked those who provided data so the Task Force could look for trends. Collin McNamara of TrueNorth Companies is working on consolidating the data into anonymized, unique categories for easier review. Mr. McNamara reiterated that he's cleaning the data, while still making sure not to exclude any data that would be beneficial for the group. He said the work is on track to provide a deliverable by the May Business Meeting.

Ted Prince of Tiger Cool Express asked the source of the data. Mr. Hunt said data sets were collected from Task Force member companies for calendar year 2020 through the date submitted. Mr. McNamara added that more data is always appreciated, so anyone who would like to submit data is encouraged to do so.



Safety Analytics and Data Working Group

Mr. McNamara said the Working Group has been working in conjunction with the Terminal Traffic Safety Task Force, so there are no additional updates.

Mr. Hunt stated the Safety Committee has a vital role to play in providing members across IANA with data that's useful for them to be able to make process decisions and improvements to their terminals. It's important to gather as much data, from as many stakeholders, as possible.

Old Business

Container Weights & Loading

Beth Pernerewski of IANA reminded the group that Container Weights and Loading is a joint Working Group with the Operations Committee. The group held an initial meeting in the fall to gauge interest. She said that the Committee Chairman, Bert Mayo of TrueNorth Companies, is talking with members who have expressed interest in leading on behalf of the Safety Committee. Ms. Pernerewski said it's important to have leadership from both the Operations and the Safety Committees for the Working Group.

New Business

Committee Priorities for 2022

Ms. Pernerewski stated the priorities are going to be the work that is underway currently, including the Terminal Traffic Safety Task Force and the Container Weights and Loading Working Group. Both are large topics for the Safety Committee to engage in. She added that anytime that there are issues that any members of the Committee have identified, they should reach out to IANA staff or the Committee's leadership.

Housekeeping and Adjournment

Hal Pollard of IANA reminded the Committee of various resources and educational opportunities available to them on IANA's website. He also reminded everyone that the Business Meeting in May will take place in person in Oak Brook, Illinois.

Mr. Prince made a motion to adjourn the meeting; it was seconded by Mr. Bronwasser. The meeting was adjourned at 1:28 p.m.
